What does this tell us about God?

What are some sins that you personally need to step away from?

Friday November 14

Romans 5:3-9

What does this passage tell us about difficulties?

What has God done for us?

What does God promise?

What does this passage tell us about God's Love?

What is an example of when you have felt helpless?

Saturday November 15

Romans 3:25-30

What does this passage tell us about God's character?

What does this passage tell us about our responsibility in dealing with sin?

How are we "made right" with God?

Sunday November 16

Matthew 6:25-34

What does this tell us about how God feels about us?

What actions are we encouraged to take?

What are some things that worry or concern you?
