A Possible Financial Breakdown:

100 people attend the dinner
They donate approximately \$5 per person = \$500
30 students participate in the Dinner and auction
Because not everyone brought supplies, we had to spend
\$20 to help cover the cost of missing food.
Each student can deduct \$16 off of their retreat cost.

Student 1 silent auctions themselves to babysit. Their winning bid is \$35.

They also auction themselves off to help with house-cleaning for \$45

This student now has \$96 to put towards any upcoming event.

Student 2 silent auctions themselves for yard work and car washing.

The winning bids are \$45 and \$25.

They also live auction themselves for general manual labor. Their winning bid is \$45

Student 2 now has \$131 for the upcoming events of their choice.

Student 3 silent auctions off some beaded necklaces and some bracelets for a total of \$35.

They also put together a basket made from donations from several stores in town. (2 Movie tickets, and some stuff from the Dollar Tree.) Because of the well done presentation, this gift basket is bid for \$50. They live auction themselves off for babysitting and because they were very kind serving dinner, their winning bid is \$50. This student now has \$146 raised and can attend a winter retreat for free!
