Dear Parents

Last month we started off with Jr High Grad Night. It was a lot of fun and it was good not only to have students participate, but also parents and other family members.



Even though we did not have students participate in the Janesville Bible Camp work a thons, we did have several of our high schoolers participate in this year's Sr High Summer camp at JBC. Being our second year leading the group after the Sr High segment had taken a thirteen year break, and as we've been reformatting the program and the structure, God is slowly bringing things together. A large majority of the group made decisions. This month we'll be mailing follow up material to them.

Both our Jr Highers and our Sr Highers enjoyed "All Nighters" last month. Thanks to all the adults who either came to help, donated food, or stayed for a while to help chaperone.

One thing that was a blessing at both all nighters was the opportunity to celebrate birthdays. It was a simple but a great way to start out the summer.

This last month we also held our 4th Serve Susanville Program. Six churches sent individuals to participate during the 6 and three day programs, though some only came for a day or part of a day to connect with an individual project. The concept of Serve Susanville consists of 4 parts:

- -To connect Christ focused churches
- -To serve and minister to the local community
- -To train and grow believers
- -To encourage and connect believers.

The Serve Susanville Project is partnered with Serve Partnerships Unlimited, a Ministry that was birthed from Youth For Christ more than 15 years ago. The Executive director of Serve Partnerships was very flexible with us and reshaped the program and the cost to better minister to us as a community. Most Mission trips cost over a thousand dollars. Most Mexico Mission trips costs hundreds of dollars. Most Ministry and Service trips in the United States cost over \$400 per person plus food and travel expenses. Typically Serve Susanville costs between \$100-175 per person. This is also less expensive than most 6-8 day Camps which normally run \$250-\$500 per person. This year, The Executive Director of Serve Partnerships set up a humongous deal for us and brought the cost down from \$175 to \$50 per person for the 6 day program. We had to decrease some of what we could offer to the community and not include rides / bounce houses this year for the family fun day, but still, more than 115 people attended the free Family Fun Day at the park. As the week was shortened to accommodate, the lower cost, we had to cut out several work projects. Though we still did projects through Crossroads and MAMA's Crisis Pregnancy Center, there were a number of things we still could have done more. Some intensive physical labor and counseling could have been done by Parents and College Students.

(Rakes, Brooms, Weed Eaters, Lawnmowers, work Gloves, Paint brushes, etc)

Assist With the family Fun Day

(Registration, Game Tables, Games, Signs, Rides, Food Prep, etc.)

Finances

(Scholarships, and funding of special projects.)

Donation Collection

Photo and Video Production

Please pray for the possibilities and for your connection with this program. Without the proper support and preparation for this program and ones like it, we may need to close down this opportunity.
